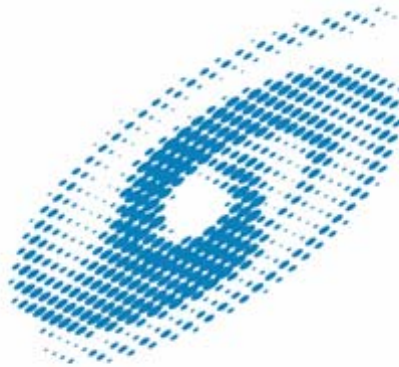


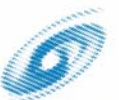

Deep Background

- An old story, and widely shared
- The recent situation
 - The “IT Deans” group -- look around the room
 - Wittgenstein’s warning
- An inherent dilemma:
 - Identity, from the Latin *idem* -- the same
 - Creating/preserving identity in turbulence
- The Identity/Legitimacy confusion



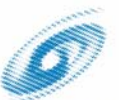
Recent Background

- IT Deans meeting Winter '02
 - Agreement on need to consider identity
- Snowbird '02
 - Identity discussion in break-outs -- “the essence”
 - Everyone agreed it's an issue
 - Everyone was flummoxed
- IT Deans meeting in Portland, '03
 - John engages in Hubris
 - Agreement to do it for real at Snowbird '04



Where It *Really* Is

- The “reaction mass” problem
 - John promises a framework people can engage
- Harder than it appears; bad if done poorly
- Snowbird logistics drives delay on the focused meeting
- Progress on the framework, however
 - At Michigan
 - Elsewhere
 - Concatenation and resynthesis
